

Anny Chen es una violinista canadiense taiwanesa actualmente estudia en el Royal College of Music, en la clase del Dr. Felix Andrievsky. ha tenido éxitos en diversos concursos internacionales, incluyendo el Concurso Internacional de Violín Kloster Schoental en Alemania (2011) y el Concurso de Violín Internacional del Norte en Rusia (2009). Como solista, Anny ha actuado en lugares tan prestigiosos como el Wigmore Hall, LSO St. Luke, San Martín del Campo y el Festival Internacional de Leeds. Anny es también una alumna del Programa Perlman Music donde recibió clases regulares con Itzhak Perlman, y la Escuela Purcell donde estudió con Evgeny Grach. Este año ha ofrecido conciertos con la Orquesta de San Pedro College, Oxford, y con la Orquesta de Cambridge y actuará también con la Finchley Chamber Orchestra el mes de noviembre. Es titular de una beca ABRSM completa en el Royal College of Music y toca un violín de Jean Baptiste Vuillaume amablemente cedido por la CRM.

Anny Chen is a Canadian-Taiwanese violinist currently studying at the Royal College of Music, in the class of Dr. Felix Andrievsky. She has had successes at international competitions including the Kloster Schoental International Violin Competition in Germany (2011) and the Violin of the North International Competition in Russia (2009). As a soloist, Anny has performed in series at prestigious venues such as the Wigmore Hall, LSO St. Luke's, St Martin in the Fields and the Leeds International Concert Series.

Anny is also an alumna of the Perlman Music Program where she had regular lessons with Itzhak Perlman, and the Purcell School where she studied with Evgeny Grach.

Concerts this year have included appearing with the St. Peter's College Orchestra, Oxford, and the Cambridge Graduates' Orchestra and she will be performing with the Finchley Chamber Orchestra this November.

She is now the holder of a full ABRSM scholarship at the Royal College of Music and plays on a Jean Baptiste Vuillaume kindly on loan from the RCM.
