

Rules and Recommendations for Your Visit

During your visit to the MUSEUM OF NAVARRE, please remember:

- In order to preserve the integrity of works of art, don't touch any object in the galleries. Even the lightest touch can damage a work of art. Please don't lean on the showcases, plinths or walls, and it is convenient to keep a safe distance from the objects on display.
- Still photography and video recordings are permitted only for strictly private use, but they may not be allowed in some temporary exhibitions and/or galleries or for some works. Cameras must be handheld and the use of flashes, floodlights and/or tripods is prohibited.
- Visitors who are visually impaired can access the museum with their guide dogs. Other animals are not allowed inside the museum premises.
- Children are most welcome at the Museum of Navarre, they will, however, be under constant supervision and control of a responsible adult. Please check at the entrance desk for activities and resources available to children.
- The gallery attendants may ask for your admission ticket for access to some of the galleries. Please keep your ticket with you throughout your visit.
- A cloakroom service is available at the entrance. For reasons of convenience and safety, all umbrellas, rucksacks, parcels and other large or sharp objects must be left in the cloakroom.
- We request your collaboration so that each visitor may make the most of their visit to the Museum of Navarre: please turn off your mobile phone while in the exhibition galleries and speak softly.
- No food or drinks are allowed inside the Museum galleries.
- Help us improve our service. There are suggestion and complaint forms available, please use them to let us know your opinion.
- If you have enjoyed your visit to the MUSEUM OF NAVARRE, recommend it to your friends. They'll thank you for it.
